<u>Adverbs</u>	<u>Forming Spanish Adverbs Ending in -mente</u>	<u>Many adverbs do not end in -mente</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • tell how, when, where • many English adverbs end in -ly • many Spanish adverbs end in -mente 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • add -mente to the end of a singular adjective • if the last letter is -o, change -o to -a and add -mente • accent marks do not change • there are irregulars 	con frecuencia (same meaning as frecuentemente) ahora pronto nunca apenas despacio (does not end in -mente) rápido (sometimes ends in -mente)

<u>English Adverb</u>	<u>Spanish Adjective</u>	<u>Spanish Adverb</u>
frequently	frecuente	frecuentemente
quickly	rápido	rápidamente
simply	simple	simplemente
generally	general	generalmente
truthfully	verdadera	verdaderamente
easily	fácil	fácilmente
absolutely	absoluto	absolutamente
completely	completo	completamente
