•	People cannot like anything in Spanish. Instead, things please people, things interest people, things fascinate people, things bother people Verbs like gustar are <u>always preceded by an indirect object pronoun</u>	mí	me
•	for whoever is receiving the action  Verbs like gustar are conjugated according to whatever is doing the action, normally in the third person singular (él, ella form) or third	ti	te
	person plural (ellos, ellas form)	usted, él, ella	le
•	It is almost always <i>inappropriate</i> to conjugate verbs like gustar in the first or second person (yo, tú, nosotros)  A prepositional phrase with a prepositional pronoun can be included	nosotros, nosotras	nos
	for emphasis or to clarify the recipient of the action	ustedes, ellos, ellas	les

Without Prepositional Phrase	With Prepositional Phrase
Me gusta correr.	A mí, me gusta correr.
Running pleases me. (I like to run.)	To me, running pleases me. (I like to run.)
¿Te interesa el libro?	A ti, ¿te interesa el libro?
Is the book interesting to you? (Are you interested in the book?)	To you, is the book interesting to you? (Are you interested in the book?)
Le fascinan los perros.	A ella, le fascinan los perros.
Dogs fascinate her. (She is fascinated by dogs.)	To her, dogs fascinate her. (She is fascinated by dogs.)
Nos importa estudiar.	A nosotros, nos importa estudiar.
Studying is important to us.	A nosotras, nos importa estudiar.
	To us, studying is important to us.
No les quedan 2 lápices.	A ellos, no les quedan 2 lápices.
Two pencils are not remaining for them. (They don't have 2 pencils remaining.)	To them, two pencils are not remaining for them. (They don't have 2 pencils remaining.)
Me faltan mis hijas.	A mí, me faltan mis hijas.
My daughters are making me feel a loss. (I miss my daughters.)	To me, my daughters are making me feel a loss. (I miss my daughters.)
¿Te molesta el calor?	A ti, ¿te molesta el calor?
Does the heat bother you?	To you, does the heat bother you?
