- express ownership
- describe a noun
- come before the noun being described
- agree in number with the noun being described
- some agree in gender with the noun being described

- tú (with accent mark) is a subject pronoun
- To be specific about ownership, "de" is often used instead of "su"

Es el libro de Miguel.

Son los libros de Miguel.
