Prepositional Pronouns - pronouns that follow a preposition

mí	me
ti, usted, ustedes	you
nosotros, nosotras	us
él	him
ella	her
ellos, ellas	them

Irregulars:

conmigo	with me
contigo	with you (familiar)

Di un abrazo a ella.

I gave a hug to her. (I gave her a hug.)

Los regalos son para mí.

The gifts are for me.

Trabajé contigo el año pasado.

I worked with you last year.

¿Recibiste los dulces de nosotras?

Did you receive the candy from us?

Ana María estudió conmigo anoche.

Ana María studied with me last night.

¿Va Juanito con ustedes al cumpleaños de su mejor amigo?

Is Juanito going with you to his best friend's birthday party?

El bonito carro nuevo es de ellos.

The pretty new car is from them. OR The pretty new car belongs to them.

A mí, me encanta montar a caballo.

To me, horseback riding pleases me.

Tenemos que hablar con ellos.

We have to talk with them.

A usted, ¿le gusta jugar al baloncesto?

To you, does it please you to play basketball?

A él, le gusta leer.

To him, reading pleases him.

¡No es para ti!

It's not for you!

A mí, siempre me gusta ir de vacaciones con ellos.

To me, it always pleases me to go on vacation with them.

Mis libros están a la derecha de él.

My books are to the right of him.

Para nosotros, es fácil practicar el español todos los días.

For us, it's easy to practice Spanish every day.
