Mis hermanas son las personas de que consigo mi ropa.

*My sisters are the people that I get my clothes from. (from whom)*

No hay otras personas que me den ropa tan bonita.

*There aren't other people that give me such pretty clothing. (who)*

La rebaja que ofrece la tienda es buena.

*The sale that the store offers is good. (which)*

Nunca vamos a encontrar otra tienda que ofrezca rebajas mejores.

*We are never going to find another store that offers better sales. (which)*

El sitio de que supe del descuento se llama zapatosbaratos.com.

*The site from that I found out about the discount is called zapatosbaratos.com. (from which)*

¿Zapatos Baratos es una tienda que vende ropa?

*Is Zapatos Baratos a store that sells shoes? (which)*

Zapatos Baratos es una tienda de que se puede comprar zapatos.

*Zapatos Baratos is a store that you can buy shoes from. (from which)*

El examen que tomamos fue difícil.

*The exam that we took was difficult. (which)*

El examen de que te quejas es fácil.

*The exam that you're complaining about is easy. (of which)*

Pedro es el estudiante de que me preguntaste.

*Pedro is the student that you asked about. (about whom)*

La señora que me ayudó era la profesora de la clase de español.

*The lady that helped me was the Spanish class professor. (who)*
