

Worksheet Answers: Spanish Relative Pronouns

Relative Pronouns

- stand for a noun in the sentence
- quien = one person, specific (who)
- quienes = more than one person, specific (who)
- que = any noun, specific (that)
- lo que = general, not people (that which)

Mis hermanas son las personas quienes/que me dieron el regalo.

My sisters are the people who gave me the gift.

Lo que me gusta es ir al parque.

That which I like is to go to the park.

Trae el libro que leemos en clase.

Bring the book that we read in class.

¿Qué es lo que quieres?

What is it (that which) you want?

En el apartamento, hay una ventana que no se abre.

In the apartment, there is a window that doesn't open.

Mi hija, que/quien trabaja en el parque, monta a caballo todos los jueves.

My daughter, who works at the park, rides horses every Thursday.

Ana María y José, quienes/que se casaron el año pasado, están esperando a un bebé.

Ana María and José, who got married last year, are expecting a baby.

¿Viste lo que nos ofrecen en la cafetería?

Did you see what they offer us in the cafeteria?

Vamos por la calle que está al lado del río.

We are going by way of the street that is located next to the river.

¿Es el libro que perdiste?

Is it the book that you lost?
