<u>Conditional Tense</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> add conditional tense verb endings to the infinitive form of the verb some verbs are irregular (like tener) <u>Used to express:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> actions that would have happened given/depending on a particular condition polite request English conditional tense uses the word “would” with another verb The imperfect tense in Spanish is used when describing an action that occurred on a regular basis. (NOT the conditional tense) 	<u>Verb Endings</u>	
	yo	-ía
	tú	- ías
	usted, él, ella	- ía
	nosotros, nosotras	- íamos
	ustedes, ellos, ellas	- ían

Expression	Tense
Would you and your sisters please come to the library? ¿Vendrían tú y tus hermanas a la biblioteca, por favor?	conditional
She believed that she would take the exam. Ella creía que tomaría el examen.	conditional
They would go out on Fridays. Ellos salían los viernes.	imperfect
Did he know she would cook dinner? ¿Sabía él que ella cocinaría la cena?	conditional
We told them that Maya would be at the party. Les dijimos a ellos que Maya estaría en la fiesta.	conditional
You would always arrive at 2:30pm. Siempre llegabas a las 2:30 de la tarde.	imperfect
When you arrived, I would get in the car immediately. Cuando llegabas, yo subía al carro inmediatamente.	imperfect
The teacher said that she would help me. La profesora dijo que me ayudaría.	conditional
Would Javier and Lisa please talk to me after class? ¿Por favor, Javier y Lisa, me hablarían después de clase?	conditional
We thought they would come early. Pensábamos que vendrían temprano.	conditional
I knew you would have the answer. Yo sabía que usted tendría la respuesta.	conditional
We doubted she would miss class on Wednesday. Dudábamos que ella faltaría clase el miércoles.	conditional
