actions that would have happened given/depending on a particular condition	nosotros,	- íamos
polite request	nosotras	
English conditional tense uses the word "would" with another verb	ustedes, ellos, ellas	- ían
<ul> <li>The imperfect tense in Spanish is used when describing an action that occurred on a regular basis. (NOT the conditional tense)</li> </ul>		

Expression	Tense
Would you and your sisters please come to the library?	conditional
¿Vendrían tú y tus hermanas a la biblioteca, por favor?	
She believed that she would take the exam.	conditional
Ella creía que tomaría el examen.	
They would go out on Fridays.	imperfect
Ellos salían los viernes.	
Did he know she would cook dinner?	conditional
¿Sabía él que ella cocinaría la cena?	
We told them that Maya would be at the party.	conditional
Les dijimos a ellos que Maya estaría en la fiesta.	
You would always arrive at 2:30pm.	imperfect
Siempre llegabas a las 2:30 de la tarde.	
When you arrived, I would get in the car immediately.	imperfect
Cuando llegabas, yo subía al carro inmediatamente.	
The teacher said that she would help me.	conditional
La profesora dijo que me ayudaría.	
Would Javier and Lisa please talk to me after class?	conditional
¿Por favor, Javier y Lisa, me hablarían después de clase?	
We thought they would come early.	conditional
Pensábamos que vendrían temprano.	
I knew you would have the answer.	conditional
Yo sabía que usted tendría la respuesta.	
We doubted she would miss class on Wednesday.	conditional
Dudábamos que ella faltaría clase el miércoles.
