<u>Present Perfect Tense</u> – expresses recent past actions	haber conjugations	
conjugate haber + past participle	уо	he
<ul> <li>past participles always end in "o" (do NOT change gender or number)</li> </ul>	tú	has
some past particples are irregular (like ver)	usted, él, ella	ha
• "ha habido" is used to describe general existence (there have been, there has been)	nosotros, nosotras	hemos
<ul> <li>expressed in English using have/has + past participle</li> </ul>	ustedes, ellos, ellas	han

I have given it to them.	
(Yo) se lo he regalado (a ellos).	
Have you already seen the teacher?	
¿Ya has visto a la maestra?	
She has always had good friends.	
Ella siempre ha tenido buenas amigas.	
We haven't eaten lunch yet.	
No hemos almorzado todavía.	
There have been problems with the book.	
Ha habido unos problemas con el libro.
